

Welcome to the 2020 Plainfield Quaker Day Parade!

We are looking forward to your participation in the Parade on Saturday, September 19 at 10 a.m. Please read these instructions carefully and direct all questions to the Plainfield Chamber of Commerce at (317) 839-3800.

Your Number/Line-up Card & Parade Judging

The number on your card indicates your placement in the parade. **You must bring this card with you on Parade Day.** Attach your entry lineup card to the right front corner of your float, car, etc. If your entry is walkers, then the person/animal on the right front corner should have the number visible at all times. It is essential that you let everyone in your group know your entry lineup number and the name of your unit (same as name on this mailing envelope address label) – especially those being dropped off at the staging area.

- Please have your entry lineup card number ready. You will be met by a volunteer who will direct you to your staging area. **Please inform everyone in your group that no vehicles will be permitted into the staging area unless they are in the parade. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- **Units being judged: Be in your designated staging position and ready no later than 9 a.m.** Your number/line-up card will be color-coded if your entry is being judged. Awards will be given for Best: Performance (yellow), Theme (red), Equestrian (pink), Antique/Classic (green), Youth (orange) and Chamber Choice (best overall).

Parade Arrival

- If your entry is not being judged, arrive between 8 and 9:30 a.m. (Judged entries must be in place by 9 a.m.).
- You must use the east entrance to enter the staging area. Parade entries will use the Duke Energy entrance located behind St. Susanna (refer to map). You can access this entrance via Dan Jones or the U.S. 40 entrance beside McCalister's deli.
- The Duke Energy entrance is for parade vehicles ONLY. You will not be permitted to enter the staging area to drop off people or supplies.
- Those dropping off people or supplies, or parking and participating in the parade must park in the St. Susanna parking lot. You must use the east entrance as the U.S. 40 entrances will be closed or used for exit only. Parade volunteers will be on hand to direct you to the staging area. Golf carts will be available to shuttle participants and supplies to the staging area.
- The west entrance to the Duke Energy parking lot at Carr Road will be open only to Duke employees and parade volunteers. No parade entries will be allowed past the guard shack.
- The parade will begin promptly at 10 a.m.

Parade Departure

- The parade will travel from Duke Energy down US 40 and will turn left on Vestal Road by McDonalds. It will travel down the hill ending at the soccer field parking area at the Al & Jan Barker Athletic Complex. (Refer to enclosed map).
- Those picking up parade participants may park in the soccer parking area. You will need to enter and exit via the back drive, Vestal Rd. to Sugar Grove Rd.
- We will not have buses available for transport back to Duke Energy. You will need to have your own transportation back to Duke Energy arranged.
